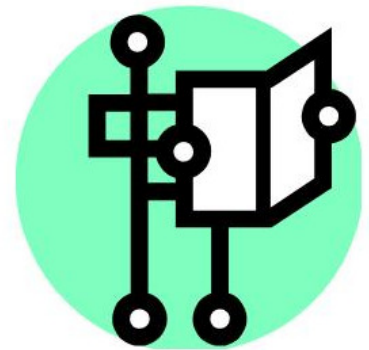

## **Carlos Westendorp, Ambassador of Spain - Background**

Carlos Westendorp assumed the position of Ambassador of Spain to the United States on Sept. 15, 2004. Ambassador Westendorp, who joined the Spanish Diplomatic Service in 1966, previously served as a member of the Madrid Parliamentary Assembly (2003-04), a member of the European Parliament (1999-2003), and High Representative for the implementation of the peace agreement in Bosnia and Herzegovina (1997-99). In addition, he has served as his country's Permanent Representative to the United Nations (1996-97), Minister of Foreign Affairs (1995-96), as well as various posts for the European communities, including State Secretary (1991-95), Permanent Representative (1985-91), President Executive of the Board for the Relations with the European Communities (1983-85) and Secretary-General (1985). Ambassador Westendorp has also served as Head of the Commercial Office of the Spanish Embassy at the Hague (1975-79), Head of the Technical Cabinet of the Ministry of Industry (1974-75), Director of Economic Studies at the Diplomatic School in Madrid (1969-70)
